Leading the company in its international expansion, Eagle has installed central offices and networks in over 33 countries worldwide for incumbent PSTN operators as well as new service providers. In this role, Rick has also pioneered new Customer Care systems and Billing systems that has resulted in Rick being awarded worldwide Patents. Rick also was responsible for signing distribution and partnership contracts with telecom's leading companies such as Alcatel, Ericsson, L-3, Harris, Navini, Titan, and others. Dial eventually expanded to several other states before being folded in Eagle in 1983. Rick started his career with New York Telephone Company where he was responsible for all competitive activity.
